This project aims to contribute to human capital development by improving learning environments and expanding educational services for vulnerable students, with a specific focus on Special Education Needs and Disability (SEND).

RESPONSIBILITY

To strengthen the Ministry of Education's and Regional Special Needs Education Diagnostic and Treatment Centre capacity by training, monitoring, and coaching a team of young professionals in the administration and interpretation of educational evaluations. The consultant will help inform student placement and eligibility for specialized services.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- a. Master's degree in Educational Psychology, Special Education, or related field;
- b. Certification/licensure as an Educational Diagnostician or equivalent (preferred).
- c. Minimum of 5 years of experience in educational assessment and diagnosis;
- d. Demonstrated experience working with children with SEND;
- e. Experience in developing and implementing IEPs;
- f. Experience in training educators and working within education systems.
